APPLICATION

Caring for people with dementia, as well as those who are susceptible to falling or wandering off, presents enormous challenges for caregivers. At the same time, those who are in need of care should not have their freedom of movement limited unnecessarily in order to ensure that their quality of life and independence is maintained within reasonable limits. The CareMat pressure-sensitive detector mat therefore provides important support in these challenges.

DAILY USE IN A PATIENT-CARE FACILITY

In patient-care facilities, the CareMat contributes significantly to maintaining the residents' quality of life and also provides valuable support to the nursing staff. The CareMat is simply placed beside the patient's bed or in front of the door to the room and is then connected to the in-house nurse call system wirelessly or by cable. As soon as a patient steps onto the mat, the CareMat triggers a signal that is relayed to the carer. The risk of falls and the dangers which can arise from patients wandering off or disorientation can be considerably reduced.

People with dementia can become restless and disoriented and often try to get up without assistance.

CareMat provides reliable protection in this area. When a patient steps onto the CareMat, the call signal triggers the in-house nurse call system. This means that the nurse can quickly come to the patient's aid.

Early intervention by the nurse can avoid potential falls. This also prevents the resident from leaving the premises without supervision.

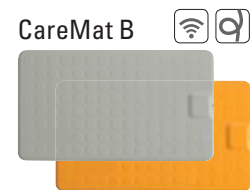
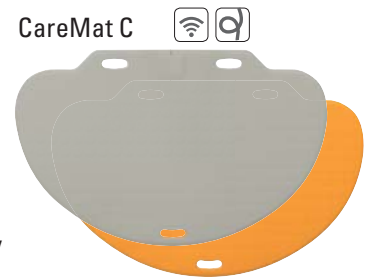

CareMat is available in a hard-wired or wireless version for placing beside a patient's bed or in front of the door to a room. The cable and the signal transmitter battery is easily replaceable.
